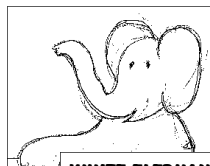
OUR NEXT MARY STAR OF THE SEA INTERFAITH COMMUNITY SUPPER WILL BE TUESDAY JUNE 30TH.
